

Dogs, Dog Leashes, and Dog Poo

The WCHOA Board continues to receive complaints concerning dogs. We are asking for all dog owners to be aware and considerate of your neighbors. Read more....

Dog Leashes: It is a City of Allen ordinance that all dogs must be kept on leashes in public spaces. People do not care for loose dogs coming up to them while on walks. Nor do they care for loose dogs coming up along their houses in the flowerbeds. When out, please keep your dog on a leash at all times.

Dog Poo: Several years ago, volunteers of the WCHOA installed six doggie stations at various locations within our community. These stations are stocked with bags and deposited dog wastes are picked up weekly. This does not include the 3-4 doggie stations installed around the City of Allen Watters Crossing Park adjacent to Norton School. In spite of these stations, the WCHOA Board receives complaints of people not picking up after their dogs. Cleaning up after your dog is another City of Allen ordinance. It is also something to do as a good neighbor and out of respect for you fellow neighbors. Your neighbors will appreciate it.
