## **ALERT - Sen. Fallon and Rep. Chen-Button have filed bills related to STR's. Stay ready to engage.**

### **Dear Texas Neighbor:**

Rep. Angie Chen-Button has filed two bills related to short-term rentals--[HB 3773](#) and [HB 3778](#)--and Sen. Fallon has filed a companion bill, [SB 1888](#).

As introduced, these bills impose substantial limitations on the ability of local communities to respond to STR's.

We ask that you take a moment to review the bills and distribute them to your neighbors and friends for their review also.

At present, these bills have not yet been assigned to committee. However, the most likely path is through the House Urban Affairs Committee where Rep. Chen-Button is currently the chair.

We will keep you updated with talking points, calls to action, and other news regarding these bills.
